School Head Training

Pretend Play Corner - where children immerse themselves in role-play scenarios that nurture empathy, communication, and creativity.

Summer Camp

Vivero Curiosity Quest: A Summer of Discovery

The Vivero Curiosity Quest Summer Camp was a vibrant, hands-on program thoughtfully designed to spark curiosity, nurture imagination, and ignite creativity in young minds. Rooted in Reggio-inspired pedagogy, the camp created a space where wonder was valued, questions were encouraged, and learning unfolded naturally through exploration.

Children were immersed in experiential activities that inspired them to inquire, observe, and construct their own understanding of the world. From sensory play and nature walks to building structures and mixing their own paint, hands-on exploration remained at the heart of every experience. These tactile, real-world engagements not only developed fine motor and problem-solving skills but also deepened connections between thought and action allowing children to learn by doing and by being.

A key highlight of the program was the seamless integration of tools and initiatives from the Nextech Studio. The introduction of age-appropriate technology and innovation tools invited children to tinker, experiment, and prototype encouraging logical thinking, creative confidence, and digital fluency. Whether designing simple machines or exploring cause-and-effect through light and sound, children embraced the world of tech through play and inquiry.

Throughout the camp, our facilitators played an intentional role - observing, listening, and scaffolding each child's interests with care. They acted not just as teachers, but as co-researchers and guides, creating an emotionally secure environment where children felt free to take risks, express themselves, and collaborate with peers.

POCSO Training

In a crucial step towards creating a secure and nurturing environment for young children, a comprehensive training program on the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences (POCSO) Act was recently conducted for our pre-school teachers, support staff, guards and bus drivers, pan India.

The training covered key aspects of the POCSO Act, including its various sections, definitions of different forms of abuse, and the stringent legal framework designed to safeguard children. Teachers were guided on recognizing the subtle signs of distress or abuse in young children, who often lack the vocabulary to express their experiences. Special emphasis was placed on understanding child behaviour, communication cues, and creating an atmosphere where children feel safe to confide.

By empowering pre-school teachers with this vital knowledge, the training not only ensured compliance with legal mandates but, underscored the belief that every child deserves to learn and grow in an environment free from fear and harm.

Training to use Fire Extinguishers

The fire safety training enhances staff preparedness and confidence and ensures compliance with safety regulations to protect our preschool community.

The purpose of drill is to familiarize all staff with the procedures to follow in the event of a real emergency. Calmly and efficiently evacuate the premise and emphasize on the importance of listening to instructions and staying together as a group.

By prioritizing fire safety training, we demonstrate our commitment to the well-being and safety of everyone in school.

First Aid Training

Conducted in collaboration with Kaveri Hospital, this training empowered our teachers and support staff to respond promptly and effectively to unexpected situations. Topics covered included handling minor injuries, managing choking, treating burns and nosebleeds, recognizing allergic reactions, and performing CPR on young children.

By equipping our team with these vital skills, we strengthen our ability to provide a safe, secure and nurturing environment where children can learn and thrive with confidence. With a well-trained team and strong safety protocols in place, we are fully equipped to handle minor incidents with care and confidence reinforcing our steadfast commitment to providing a safe, responsive, and child-centric learning environment at Vivero.


