Refresher Training







Refresher trainings play a vital role in re-energizing teachers, strengthening their skills, and offering fresh perspectives that enhance both personal well-being and classroom practice. As part of our Mid-Year Refresher Training, we dedicated a session to the well-being of our teachers, facilitated by Ashrita Lokhande from the ZenYogaShala. The session included gentle body alignment practices and breathwork to improve posture and bring calm, guided meditation to reduce stress and build patience, and sound healing with Tibetan bowls for deep relaxation. These practices aimed to enhance emotional resilience, provide practical mindfulness tools, and support teachers in managing stress effectively, both personally and within the classroom environment.

Alongside wellness, the refresher focused on academic growth and pedagogical development. Teachers engaged in workshops on time management, ensuring smooth classroom transitions and efficient use of teaching time, and explored strategies for meaningful parent communication. Sessions on Reggio-inspired practices encouraged making learning visible and inquiry-based, while brain development in early years aligned teaching strategies with developmental milestones. Additionally, grade-wise collaborative discussions allowed teachers to reflect, share best practices, and co-create innovative solutions. The training provided a holistic platform for teachers to recharge, gain clarity, and return to their classrooms with renewed purpose.

Children had a wonderful time celebrating this day with their buddies exploring activities and laying the foundation for strong friendships and positive relationships in the future.


















Teachers' Day Celebration - A Heartfelt Tribute

The week highlighted how literacy grows stronger when families and communities join in. It was a celebration filled with laughter, imagination, and the timeless joy of stories.












Dandiya Beats

Provocations and inquiry-based activities spark wonder, encouraging children to ask questions, explore, and construct knowledge through hands-on experiences. Creative writing, graphic illustrations, and mind maps make their thinking visible, allowing them to connect ideas across subjects. The voices of children are captured through photographs, reflections, and questions, valuing their perspectives and thought processes. Learning corners with loose parts provide open-ended spaces for experimentation, problem-solving, and imaginative play, while documentation boards serve as living narratives that showcase learning journeys, discoveries, and moments of reflection.

Collaboration and peer learning are celebrated, as children share ideas, negotiate solutions, and co-create understanding. Teachers act as co-learners and facilitators, observing, guiding, and extending learning based on children's interests. Every activity and material is thoughtfully designed to inspire curiosity, creativity, and exploration. Through these practices, children develop critical thinking, confidence, and agency while engaging deeply with concepts. Reflection and dialogue are central, helping children articulate thoughts and learn from one another. Our Reggio-inspired classrooms transform learning into a dynamic, responsive, and meaningful journey that honors the uniqueness of every child.


